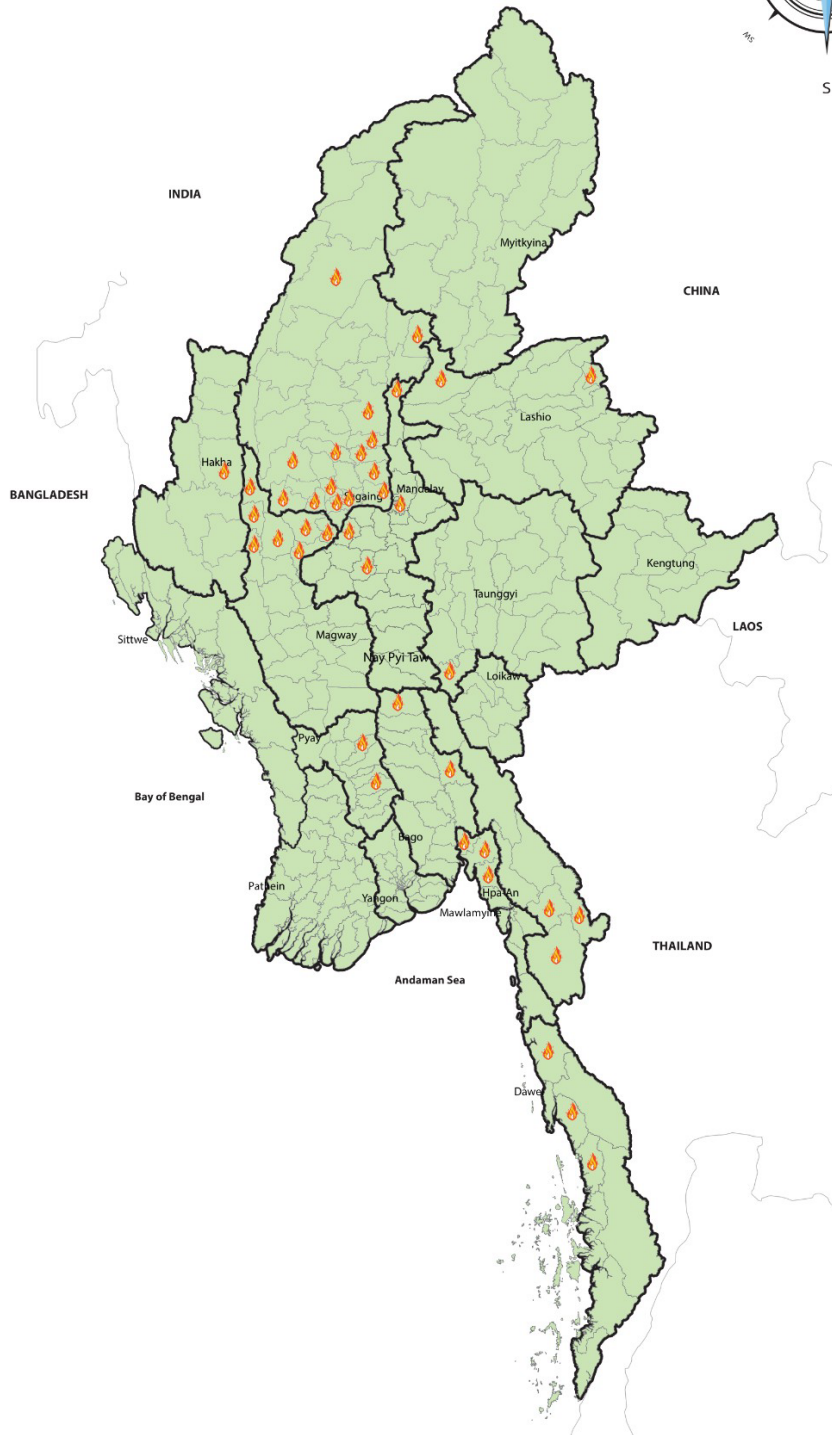
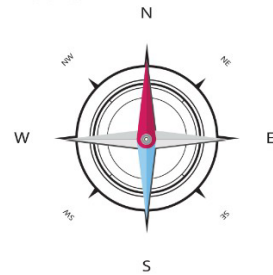

June 1, 2023

Strikes

Locals organize boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Taze township, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Latpataung Hill in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township in the Ayeyarwady region.

Locals hold protests against MOGE, calling for sanctions against the company in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Two SAC police members were killed when PDFs raided the Wanbao police gate and lounge building in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs near Htin Chaung village, Mindat township, Chin State.

More than two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs at the Than Tadar SAC camp along the Bilin and Kyaikto border in Bilin township, Mon state.

20 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs near Htin Thi Mit village, Hakha township, Chin State.

Human Rights Violations

As a result of arson by SAC troops, the main power lines in Yint Ye village caught on fire and there were power outages in nearby villages in Saw township, Magway region.

SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Thin Gan Tone village, in Dawei township, Tanintharyi region. More than five houses were burned down, two civilians were injured, and two civilians were arrested.

The junta launched an airstrike, early in the morning, in Moby township of southern Shan State, causing destruction to several homes. One of the structures destroyed included the security outpost of the Kayan New Liberation Army on the border between Khan and Kayah in Kayah (Karenni) State.

Seven houses were burned down in Ywar Thit village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Three houses were burned down in Tha Byu Chan Kone and Kone Tan Lay villages in Sagaing township.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Ka Lane Aung town, Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region.

June 2, 2023

Strikes

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in Monywa township and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region and in Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Locals continue to hold boycotts and call for sanctions on MOGE in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

One child, one monk and one civilian were killed and another two civilians were injured in a clash between CDFs and SAC forces in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin state.

There was a drone attack organized by PDFs on SAC forces at the SAC checkpoint in Pakokku township, Magway region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs at the SAC's checkpoint along the Moke Pa Lin crossroad in Kyaikto township, Mon State.

One SAC soldier were killed in a clash with CDFs at Tha Rine village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs. The SAC soldiers were part of the no (15) infantry battalions based in Myingyan township, Mandalay region.

Six SAC police members and two PDFs soldiers were killed in a clash between the two forces at the SAC checkpoint near Don Tha Mi bridge near Nyar Da Wae village in Thaton township, Mon state.

Six SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs in Yesagy township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

One child and four civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Shwe Yaung Pya village in Bilin township, Mon State.

SAC forces burned down Kyi Ai village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Three children and three civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Lhaee Lam Kuu village in Kyaikto township, Mon State.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Ma Yan Sein Lay village, Thandaunggyi township, Kayin State.

June 3, 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

PDF joining forces attacked SAC offices, the Kyainseikgyi police station, and the 284th infantry battalion headquarters under the SAC in Kayin State. There were many injuries and casualties from both sides.

More than 45 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs at the Duyin Sate bridge in Thaton township, Mon State.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs at Ta Lat Pan Pin cemetery in Ingabo village, Kyaikto township, Mon state.

There was a clash between CDFs and SAC forces at the garment factory near Koe Pin village in Pakokku township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Moe Byel town in Pekon township, Shan (south) State.

More than 100 houses burned down and 50 civilians were arrested when SAC forces set fire to Na Bal Pin Hla village in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were killed and one injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Shwebo village in Gangaw township, Magway region.

June 4, 2023

Strikes

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Latpataung Hill in the Sagiang region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs near the immigration office in Chaung-U township, Sagaing region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another injured in a clash with CDFs near Lat Pan Khone village, Paungde township, Bago region.

10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs near Htin Thi Mit bridge in Hakha township, Chin state.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs in the SAC camp located at the monastery in Zayet Gyi village, Taungtha township, Mandalay region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the SAC's camp in Htee Saung village, Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs near San village, Saw township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

Two civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Min Htain village in Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

65 Houses were burned down when SAC forces burned down Kan Thit village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

June 5, 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Monywa township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region; the Yangon region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with CDFs in Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

10 SAC soldiers and two CDF soldiers were killed in a clash at the SAC's camp in Zee Phyu Kone village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and four injured in a clash with CDFs at Lay Thwe and Tha Yar Phi villages in Pauk township, Magway region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs along Pakokku - Mindat road in Pauk township, Magway region.

Human Rights Violations

SAC forces launched an airstrike, dropping bombs near Zee Phyu Kone village in Pale township, Sagaing region.

50 houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Htan Chaung village in Yesagyö township, Sagiang region.

Six civilians were injured when SAC fired mortar bombs at Let Pan Chaung village in Kale township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another four injured when SAC forces launched an airstrike on a school in Shu Khin Thar village, Kale township, Sagaing region.

Three houses were destroyed and three civilians injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Gway Thae village in Yedashe township, Bago region.

Three civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Moe Byel town in Pekon township, Shan (south) State.

SAC forces launched an airstrike on Ah Lal Rambo village, Mabein township, Shan (north) State).

June 6, 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, Yinmarbin township, and the northside of Yinmarbin in the

Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region; Myaing township, Magway region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

More than 40 SAC soldiers and four PDF soldiers were killed in a clash between the two forces at the police station and the SAC camp in the Nat Tan Kwin area in Kyaukkyi township, Bago region.

More than 20 SAC soldiers and three civilians were killed in a clash with PDFs near Sat Taw village along the Homalin-Paungbyin border in Homalin township, Sagaing region.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp in Zayet Gyi village, Taungtha township, Mandalay region.

More than 20 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with MNDAA forces in Shan (north) State.

Five SAC soldiers and one CDF soldier were killed in a clash between the two forces in the lower part of Thee Mit between Hakha-Thantlang, Hakha township, Chin State.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Moe Byel town, Pekon townshpi, Shan (south) State.

Human Rights Violations

Some schools and houses were damaged when the SAC military jets bombed an area near Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

One child and four civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Tar Han Ward in Kale township, Sagaing region.

Two houses and one car were damaged when SAC military jet fighters fired at Sin Htoe village in Tilin township, Magway region.

June 7, 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township, the eastside of Yinmarbin, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Of the 50 political parties that re-applied for registration, 22 parties were approved by the Military Council Election Commission.

Military Clashes

SAC military troops attempted to penetrate and patrol an area secured already by PDF joint forces near Myawaddy township in the Kayin State. A skirmish between the two sides took place, and the SAC military was pushed back and forced to retreat.

11 SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs at Thayet Kaung Pin village in Mahlaing township, Mandalay region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs in Myingyan township, Mandalay region.

12 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDF forces at the SAC camp at the monastery in Chaung Nyiko village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the police station and SAC camp in Tabayin township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the Shein Ma Kar police station, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

18 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC militia's village, which is Tal Thee Taw village in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Kawlin township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

The SAC military fired 120 mm weapons in Ywar Tan Shay village in Kawkareika township, Kayin State. A 12-year-old boy was killed and his mother and his 4-year-old sister were injured.

Two houses were burned down by SAC forces when they set fires in Oke Tu village, Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region.

Military council troops opened fire in Okpho township, Bago region; a motorcycle rider was seriously wounded and another two people were arrested.

15 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Moe Gyo Pyin village, Salingyi township, Sagaing region.
