

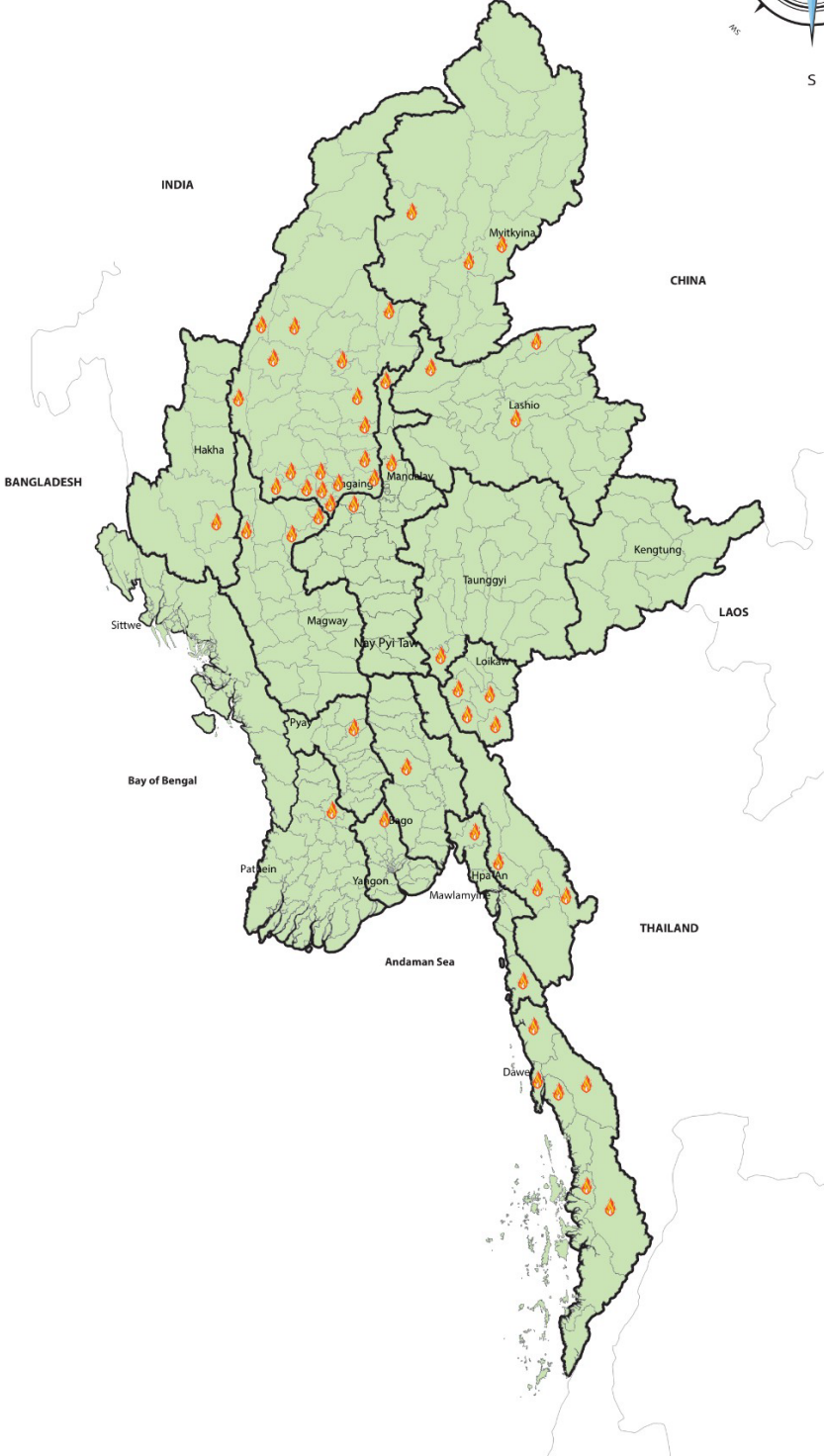
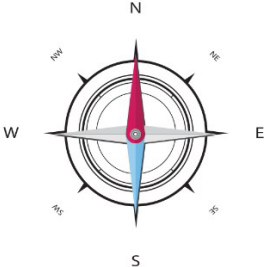

**Strikes**

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salinyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung hill, and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region.

**Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

**Military Clashes**

Five SAC soldiers were killed and more than 10 were seriously injured when a military column of the SAC's forces entered the YRA's mine field near G Creek in Tilin township, Magway region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and more than five were injured in a clash with PDFs at the SAC checkpoint in Myaing township, Magway region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near No (8) Ward in Kamma township, Magway region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs between Ta Fan Kone and Ta Kaung Min villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Three young teenagers were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Ta Kon Tine village in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin state.

One monk and six civilians were injured when SAC forces fired a mortar bomb near the monastery in Ywar Thar village, Tilin township, Magway region.

One child was killed and another 12 children and one civilian were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at East santha village in Kale township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were killed and 15 houses were burned down when SAC forces burned down Ta Fan Kone and Ta Kaung Min villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

## **June 23, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township and Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region.

### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

### **Military Clashes**

15 SAC soldiers were killed when the SAC military gate based in Zinkalin village, south of Kale township, Sagaing region was attacked by PDFs.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by KIA forces near Gaung Yi village, between Ta Nine and Kar Mine, Hpakan township, Kachin State.

20 SAC soldiers were killed and more than 30 injured in a clash with PDFs in Seikphyu township, Magway region.

One SAC police member was killed and another seven injured by a mine attack organized by KIA forces in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

30 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the SAC's camp near Ohn Dan village, Mogoke township, Mandalay region.

Eight SAC soldiers and one PDF member were killed in a clash between the two forces at the SAC's camp in Ta Mine Kone village, Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Three civilians were killed when a military jet bombed a place where there was no fighting: Thay Kho village in the west of Hpruso township, Kayan (Karenni) State.

Six civilians were arrested by patrolling SAC troops in Hinthada township, Ayeyarwady region.

One child and two civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs into Nabar village, Indaw township, Sagaing region.

Eight civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Nyaung Pin Sought village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was arrested by SAC forces from Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

## **June 24, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals continue to boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Myaing township, Magway region.

### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

### **Military Clashes**

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Mese township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Than Lwin Bridge, Hpasawng township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

One PDF soldier was killed in a clash with SAC forces near Bone Bwae village, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the SAC's camp in No (4) Phaung Taw Oo Ward in Yesagyo township, Magway region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by KIA forces on the police station in Ngan Myar village, Ngazun township, Mandalay region.

Two SAC police soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near the police station in Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

One civilian was killed and another nine were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs into Tel Su village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were killed by SAC forces in Muse township, Shan (North) State.

SAC forces burned down Nyaung Pin Gyin village in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were killed by SAC forces in Tanintharyi and Launglon townships, Tanintharyi region.

### **June 25, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township in the Sagaing region; and in the Yangon region.

#### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

#### **Military Clashes**

12 PDF soldiers were killed when SAC troops launched a surgical attack early in the morning at the PDF camp near Indaw village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another five injured by a mine attack organized by KIA forces in Htan Chaung village, Yesagyo township, Magway region.

One SAC soldier was killed and another six injured in a clash with PDFs in Shwe Lay Area, Paungde township, Bago region.

One PDF soldier was killed in a clash with SAC forces in Kan Thar Yar village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces at the police station in Hnit Kayin village, Ye township, Mon State.

### **Human Rights Violations**

One civilian was killed when the army entered Thar Si village, in Kale township, Sagaing region. The village was burned down and the troops opened fire on civilians with heavy weapons.

Two civilians were killed when SAC troops, on a helicopter, fired at the civilians in Hnit Kayin village, Ye township, Mon State.

SAC forces burned down Thein Taw and Myin Taw villages in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another two injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Kan thar Yar village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Myint Nge ward, Myeik township, Tanintharyi region.

Two PDF soldiers were killed by SAC forces from Sar Taung town, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Four civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Nga Phae Inn and Tha Min Inn Kone villages in Kyauktaga township, Bago region.

### **Political and International Events**

The military council and the ceasefire ethnic armed groups organized a three-day-long meeting in Nay Pyi Taw.

**June 26, 2023**

**Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, and Wetlet township in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Myaing township, Magway region.

### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

### **Military Clashes**

Seven SAC soldiers were killed when the Dragon Princess Military Camp was attacked by the People Defense Force Battalion (4) near Tamu township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by KIA forces near Shar Taw village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

One PDF soldier was killed in a clash with SAC forces in southern Kale Township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Paungde township, Bago region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another six injured in a clash with PDFs near Myint Taw village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by KIA forces in Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Eight SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by KIA forces near Ohn Taw village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Four houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to the houses near Nga Ye village in Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region.

One civilian was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Pa Wati and Kyaung Nyent villages in Palaw township, Tanintharyi region.

15 PDF soldiers and three civilians were killed by SAC forces at the PDF's camp near King Taw village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Three civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Aye Mya Tharyar Ward in Myintkyina township, Kachin State.

### **Political and International Events**

The military council and the ceasefire ethnic armed groups organized a three-day-long meeting in Nay Pyi Taw.

## **June 27, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's elections in the following places: Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Kale township, Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin and Salingyi township in Sagaing region.

### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

### **Military Clashes**

15 SAC soldiers were killed in an attack launched by joint PDF forces on Monywa Ka-nya-na office (Road Transportation Administration Office) in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash organized by PDFs near Kyune Pin Bu village in Paungde township, Bago region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Kyauk Htu Town in Saw township, Magway region was attacked 12 times by SAC fighter jets.

SAC forces set fires in the Nyaung Pin Gyi Area, burning down three villages in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Four civilians were killed when SAC fighter jets fired bullets in Nan Kit village, near Phasawng township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Ye Lal Kyun Area, Yesagyo township, Magway region.

One monk and eight civilians were killed when SAC jet fighters fired at Nyaung Kone village, Pale township, Sagaing region.

**June 28, 2023**

### **Strikes**

Locals held protests against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung hill, and Yinmarbin township in Sagaing; Yesagyoo township, Magway region.

### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

### **Military Clashes**

SAC military troops came under mine attack for two consecutive days on the Pakokku-Kamma road in Pakokku township, Magway region. Two SAC soldiers were killed in this attack.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and another two injured by a mine attack organized by KIA forces on the city bypass road in Myinmu township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers and five SAC police members were killed by a drone attack organized by KIA forces at the city police station in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

16 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs on Mawlamyine-Ye-Dawei road in Ye township, Mon State.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Shwe Aung Thar village, Mindat township, Chin state.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a bomb attack organized by KIA forces at the No. (22) infantry division headquarters in Hpa-An township, Kayin State.

14 PDF soldiers were killed when attempting to defend against the junta invasion on the region in northwest Myanmar in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

Two civilians were injured by SAC fighter jets who fired at Myaught Yamar Dam in Pale township, Sagaing region.

SAC forces burned down Pint Thar village in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

Eight civilians were killed and another seven injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Baw Di Kwin village, Kyauktaga township, Bago region.

30 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Kawthoung township, Tanintharyi region.

150 Houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Ngar Pet Chaung village in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

### **Political and International Events**

### **June 29, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salinyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung hill, and Yinmarbin township in Sagaing; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

#### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

#### **Military Clashes**

Members of the SAC military group that came to inspect Bilin bridge in Bilin township, Mon State were attacked; many were killed and injured.

17 SAC soldiers, including army officers, were killed when the general office of the police station in the city of Wetlet in Wetlet township, Sagaing region was bombed.

15 SAC soldiers were injured in a clash with PDFs near Koe Taung Bot village, Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

PDFs organized a drone attack on SAC forces at the Nyaung Pin Wun police station in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Ngar Pet Chuang village in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at Kan Gyi Kone village, Chaung-U township, Sagaing region.

#### **Human Rights Violations**

One civilian was arrested by SAC forces from Daik-U township, Bago region.

10 Civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Shwepyithar township, Yangon region.

SAC forces fired at villages near Wetlet township, sometimes using fighter jets, in the Sagaing region.

Four houses were burned down when SAC forces set fire to Thar Si village in Kale township, Sagaing region.

### **Political and International Events**

Military council talked with 5 Nationwide Ceasefire Agreement signatories at the Nay Pyi Taw in Myanmar.

### **June 30, 2023**

#### **Strikes**

Locals boycott the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Latpataung hill, and Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region.

#### **Election Updates**

Nothing to report.

#### **Military Clashes**

The Karenni National People's Liberation front took down an attack helicopter that was flying near the Thai-Myanmar border in Bawlakhe township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

There was a drone attack on PDFs organized by SAC forces at the Sar Taung police station in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at Ywar Thit village in Bawlakhe township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Maung Mal Shaung village, Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed when PDFs fired mortar bombs at the No. 97 light-infantry regiment in Kawkareik township, Kayin State.

One SAC soldier was killed and another five injured in a clash with PDFs at Ngar Lone Pyout village, Madaya township, Mandalay region.

Four SAC soldiers were killed when PDFs fired a mortar bomb at Pone Nar Gyi village, Thabeikkyin township, Mandalay region.

### **Human Rights Violations**

One civilian was killed and one house was burned down when a SAC airplane bombed Wan Awng village, Hpasawng township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Four civilians were killed and another two injured by SAC forces in Sa Mone village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

160 Houses were burned down by SAC forces in Ngar Pet Chuang and Tha Yet Pin Sate villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed and another two injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Nag Ta Yaw village, Yesagyio township, Magway region.
