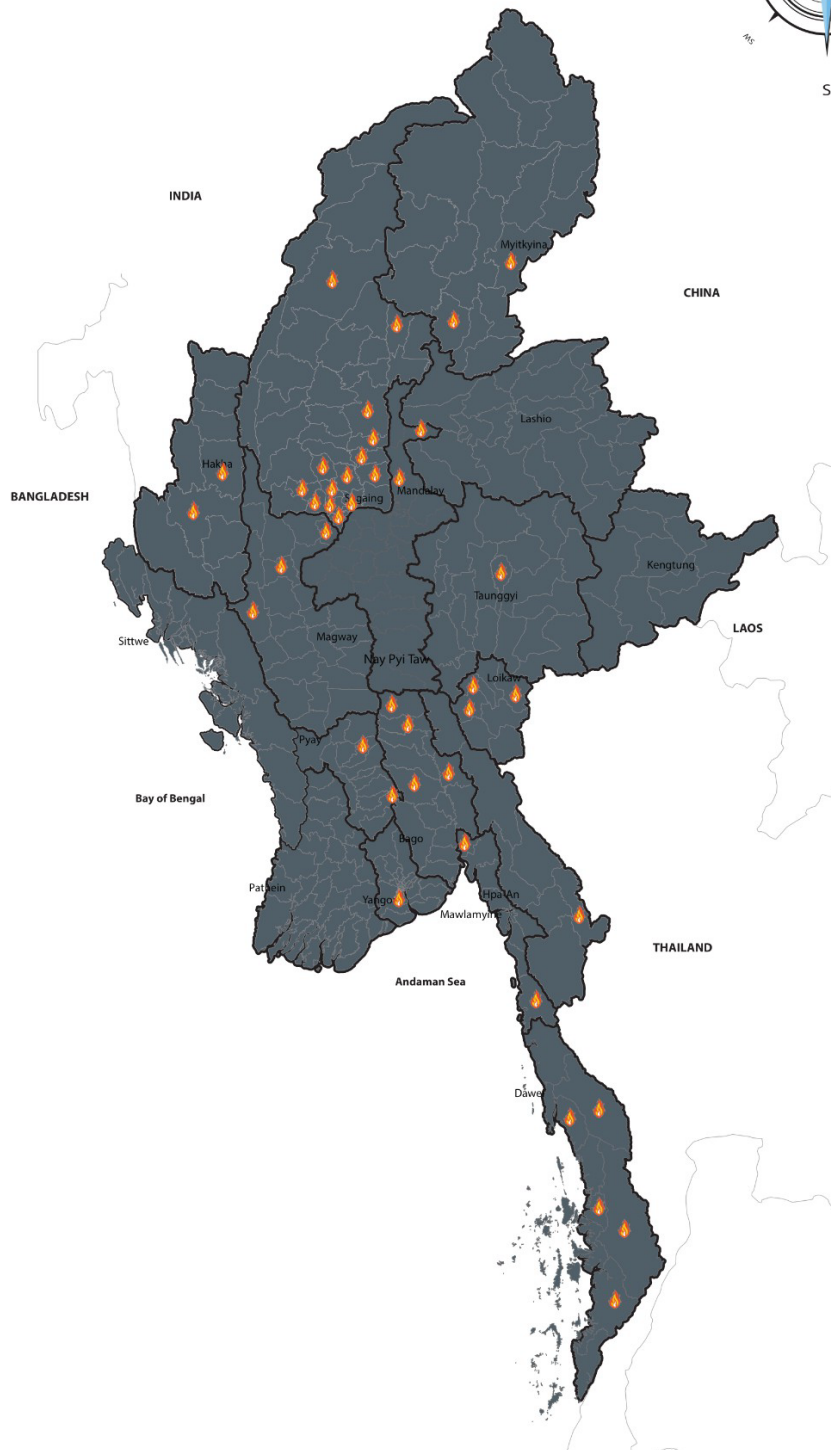
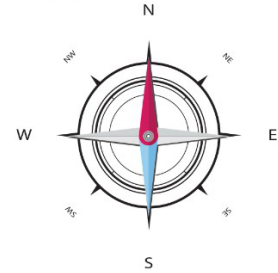

Strikes

Locals protest the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township, Latpataung hill, and Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Four SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near the lemon farm in Yebyu township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC soldiers, two PDF soldiers, and two civilians were killed in a clash between PDF and SAC forces near Kaw Kan village, Paungbyin township, Sagaing region.

12 SAC soldiers were killed in a mine attack organized by PDFs near Alu Lay village, Bilin township, Mon State.

10 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the SAC camp in Mawlaik township, Sagaing region.

20 SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Thar Si village, Kale township, Sagaing region.

Human Rights Violations

Four civilians were arrested when junta army forced non-CDM teachers to serve as porters in Indaw township, northern Sagaing region.

One child and one civilian were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at the Ye Lal Kyun Area in Yesagyio township, Magway region.

One child and one civilian were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Mal Ka Nal village in Myawaddy township, Kayin State.

Four civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Kyaw Zayar Ward in Kawlin township, Sagaing region.

Two houses were burned down by SAC forces in Ban La Myut village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Six civilians were arrested by SAC forces from the Mandalay region.

Strikes

Locals boycotted the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township, and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Military Clashes

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in the Ingabo Area in Kyaikto township, Mon State.

13 SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the SAC's camp near Shwe Kyin village in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces along Kan Pike T road in Waingmaw township, Kachin State.

Five SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the police station in Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the police station in Myaung township, Sagaing region.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs between Thae Phyu Chaung and Myoe Din villages in Madaya township, Mandalay region.

Two SAC police members and two civilians were killed in a clash with PDFs near the Zigon police station in Letpadan township, Bago region.

Seven SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the SAC's camp located by Than Datar Gate between Kyaikto and Bilin township, Mon State.

Human Rights Violations

One civilian was killed by SAC forces at Aung Chan Thar village, Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

One child was killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Pauk Eu village in Yesagyo township, Magway region.

Political and International Events

July 3, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's elections in the following places: Yinmarbin township, Monywa township, the northside of Yinmarbin, and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

There was a clash between KIA and SAC forces near Nant San Yan village in Laiza Town, Waingmaw township, Kachin State.

There was a clash between CDF and SAC forces in Hakha township, Chin State.

Five SAC soldiers were killed by a drone attack organized by PDFs on the SAC's camp near Chaung Hna Khwa police station, Kyaikmaraw township, Mon State.

One SAC soldier was killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs near King village in Myaung township, Sagaing region.

There was a drone attack organized by PDFs on SAC forces between Taung Bain and Kyel Htain Kone village, Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Human Rights Violations

Two civilians were injured and four houses destroyed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Muu town in Nyaunglebin township, Bago region.

Two civilians were arrested by SAC forces from Shwepyithar township, Yangon region.

Nine houses were burned down by SAC forces from Ma Gyi Kone village in Kanbalu township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was injured by SAC troops' gunfire in Kanpetlet township, Chin State.

Two civilians were killed by SAC forces near Kawt village, Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

July 4, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's elections in the following places: Yinmarbin-Salingyi township, the eastside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township and the northside of Yinmarbin in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Five PDF soldiers were killed and more than 100 houses were burned down when after midnight the SAC army raided Ta Line village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Three SAC soldiers were injured by a mine attack organized by PDFs near Yit Ma Hill in Paungde township, Bago region.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs between Myay Tuu and Shan Su villages in Yedashe township, Bago region.

Nine SAC soldiers were killed by a mine attack organized by PDFs near Inpin Chaung Yoe bridge in Seikphyu township, Magway region.

More than 10 SAC soldiers were killed and 15 injured in a clash with PDFs near Thamin Inn Kone village, Kyauktaga township, Bago region.

More than five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Two CDF soldiers were killed in a clash with SAC forces on Lon Khar Hill in Hakha township, Chin State.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs between Shwe Nyaung Taw and Min villages in Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at the SAC's camp near Kyaikmaraw paper machine in Kyaikto township, Mon State.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Loi Lin Lay town, Loikaw township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Human Rights Violations

One child and two civilians were injured when SAC forces sent fighter jets into the refugee camp in Demoso township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

Five civilians were injured when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at East Maw Tone village in Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces at the SAC camp near Chaung Hna Khwa police station in Kyaikmaraw township, Mon State.

One house was burned down and six civilians were arrested when SAC forces set fires in Aut Tuo village in Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region.

Political and International Events

July 5, 2023

Strikes

Locals held boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in the following places: the northside of Yinmarbin, Yinmarbin township, Latpataung hill, and Ayadaw township in the Sagaing region; Myaing township, Magway region; Launglon township, Tanintharyi region; Kyangin township, Ayeyarwady region.

Election Updates

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near San Ma Aine village in Paungde township, Bago region.

Five SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs in Myeik and Bokpyin township in Tanintharyi region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed and five injured in a clash with PDFs near Taung Kha Maught village in Paungde township, Bago region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a drone attack organized by PDFs at the SAC camp in Kyainseikgyi township, Kayin State.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at Tone Byaw Gyi village in Myeik township, Tanintharyi region.

One SAC soldier was killed in a clash with PDFs near La Ngu and Taung Bain villages in Tanintharyi township, Tanintharyi region.

Five SAC soldiers were injured in a drone attack organized by PDFs at the SAC gate in Mae Yone Lay village, Kyaikto township, Mon State.

Human Rights Violations

Eight civilians were arrested by the military after an attack on Letpadan police station and a gambling ring in Aung Mingalar village in Letpadan township, Bago region.

One PDF soldier and one civilian were killed by SAC forces along the Shwebo-Kyauk Myauing road in Shwebo township, Sagaing region.

Five houses were burned down by SAC forces in Thin Gyun Tone village, Dawei township, Tanintharyi region.

Political and International Events

Nothing to report.

July 6, 2023

Strikes

Locals hold boycotts against the SAC's 2023 elections in Yinmarbin-Salingyi township and Latpataung hill in the Sagaing region and Launglon township, Tanintharyi region.

Locals hold protests calling for sanctions on MOGE in the northside of Yinmarbin, Sagaing region.

Locals protest against China, calling for the government to stop supporting the military and to respect the peoples' voice in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Six SAC soldiers were killed and two officers injured and one PDF soldier were killed in Sharrtaw vattle in Shadaw township, Kayah (Karenni) State. The weapons and ammunition of the military were confiscated by PDF troops.

Three SAC soldiers and three PDF members were killed in a clash between the two forces near Ah Myint police station, Chaung-U township, Sagaing region.

There was a drone attack organized by PDFs on SAC forces in Ta Line village, Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Two SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Shwe Kone village in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDF and SAC forces in Ngwe Twin village, Ayadaw township, Sagiang region.

Human Rights Violations

More than 100 houses were burned down by SAC forces in Ta Line village in Sagaing township, Sagaing region.

Seven civilians were killed and 30 civilians were arrested by SAC forces in Ta Ma Yoe village, Wetlet township, Sagaing region.

Almost 100 houses were burned down by SAC forces in Thapyay Hla, Chaung Wa and Bo Kone villages in Shwegu township, Kachin State.

15 Civilians were killed when SAC forces fired mortar bombs at Ngwe Twin village in Ayadaw township, Sagaing region.

One civilian was killed by SAC forces in Sar Khar village, Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events

July 7, 2023

Strikes

Locals boycott the SAC's elections in the following places: Yesagyo township, Salingyi township, Monywa township, the northside of Yinmarbin and Yinmarbin-Salingyi township in the Sagaing region; Thayetchaung township, Tanintharyi region; Myaing township, Magway region.

Election Updates

Nothing to report.

Military Clashes

Two SAC soldiers were killed by landmines while returning from delivering rations near Taw Pu village in Monywa township, Sagaing region.

Six SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs at the monastery in Ban Mon village, Mogoke township, Mandalay region.

One SAC police soldier was killed when PDFs fired mortar bombs at the city police station in Salingyi township, Sagaing region.

There was a mine attack on PDFs on SAC forces near Myaught Taw Gyi village, Budalin townshi, Sagaing region.

There was a clash between PDFs and SAC forces at the SAC camp located by the communication tower in Khaw Zar town, Ye township, Tanintharyi region.

Three SAC police were killed and another three injured in a clash with PDFs on the Yangon-Mandalay highway road in Taungoo township, Bago region.

Three SAC soldiers were killed in a clash with PDFs near Sain Lae Myaing in Mtyawaddy township, Kayin State.

Human Rights Violations

One house was destroyed when a SAC fighter jet fired at Khi Lo Payar village in Hpruso township, Kayah (Karenni) State.

SAC forces burned down Kone Gyi village in Khin-U township, Sagaing region.

One child and two civilians were killed by SAC forces between Tal Pin Kan and Shwe Pan Khaing villages in Yinmarbin township, Sagaing region.

Political and International Events
