REPORT ON MASSACRES COMMITTED BY THE MYANMAR MILITARY JUNTA IN 2025

AN ANALYTICAL REVIEW BASED ON LOCAL MEDIA REPORTS

Introduction

Myanmar has endured persistent conflict since the military coup in February 2021, with widespread reports of violence against civilians. According to the [Assistance Association for Political Prisoners](#), since the military coup in February 2021, over 7,600 civilians have lost their lives, and more than 30,000 individuals are currently being held arbitrarily. Additionally, a UN report from June 2025 indicates that approximately 3.5 million people have been displaced due to the ongoing conflict.

In 2025, incidents described as massacres—deliberate, large-scale killings of unarmed civilians—became distressingly frequent. The [Burmese Democratic Futures Working Group](#) (BDFWG) conducted an in-depth review of local media sources to systematically document these massacres carried out by the Myanmar military junta.

This report aims to provide an objective analysis of these events using data sourced from local media, with standardized terminology and regional names to ensure clarity for a broad audience. The findings are intended to inform human rights researchers, policy analysts, and the general public about the scale, nature, and distribution of massacres in Myanmar during 2025.

Definition of 'Massacre'

For the purposes of this report, a 'massacre' is defined as the intentional killing of five or more unarmed civilians in a single incident or coordinated series of actions, perpetrated by the military junta, regardless of motive. This definition excludes armed clashes and focuses on events targeting non-combatants. There are no known reports of democratic forces committing massacres against civilians.

Methodology

To ensure the reliability of this analysis, BDFWG gathered data exclusively from local news outlets. These sources are more reliable than national news, which is controlled by the military junta and known to spread propaganda. Local news outlets often have direct access to local organizations and individuals within Myanmar, and are able to offer first-hand accounts from civilians. Each locally reported incident was thoroughly cross-referenced with other media and civilians in Myanmar to confirm the accuracy of casualty counts and event locations. Special attention was given to verifying the motives and location of each massacre.

Data Compilation and Terminology

This report presents findings based on local media reports of massacre incidents in Myanmar during 2025. Terminology has been revised for consistency, and all regional names are

standardized. The analysis includes a summary table organized chronologically and highlights the methods used in the massacres.

For clarity and consistency, all references to 'military commission' or 'military council' are now updated to 'military junta.' Regional names have been standardized, Ayeyarwady is presented as Irrawaddy, Karenni as Karenni, and Karen as Karen. This approach aims to assist human rights researchers, policy analysts, and the general public in understanding the full extent and nature of these tragic events.

Key Findings

The investigation identified 114 separate massacres perpetrated by the military junta throughout Myanmar in 2025. According to initial news, these violent incidents resulted in the deaths of more than 1,146 civilians, including women and children.

Regional Distribution and Nature of Massacres

The majority of massacres in Myanmar have been concentrated in the central and northwestern regions, specifically Sagaing Region, Mandalay Region, and Magway Region which together account for 65 out of the 114 documented massacres. Sagaing Region is the most impacted, with a total of 32 incidents. Mandalay Region follows with 18 massacres, while Magway Region has recorded 15. Rakhine State has reported 14 incidents, Northern Shan State has had 9, Kachin State has experienced 6, and Karenni State has seen 6 massacres. Karen State have reported 3 massacres and Bago Region have reported 4 massacres. Chin State has had 2, and the Irrawaddy Region, Taninthary Region, Mon State, and Southern Shan State have each experienced one massacre. Notably, the Yangon Region and Nay Pyi Taw were the only regions where no massacres were reported.

Of the 114 reported massacres, 97 were carried out through aerial attacks on civilian locations. These attacks included 11 strikes on monasteries, 8 on internally displaced persons (IDP) camps, 5 assaults on hospitals, 3 attacks on schools, 2 on local teashops/restaurants where people gather, 2 at wedding receptions, and 1 during a funeral procession. The airstrikes were deliberately aimed at locations with large gatherings of people, such as monasteries, IDP camps, hospitals, schools, wedding receptions, and funeral homes. Of these, the Oththingdwin village massacre of May 2025, where more than 20 underaged children were killed, and the Mrauk-U Hospital massacre of December 2025, which resulted in the deaths of over 30 hospitalized civilians, are among the most widely reported incidents.

Additionally, 12 massacres arose from ground operations targeting villages, during which civilians were arrested, tortured, and killed, and the villages were set on fire. Among those 12 incidents, there were also cases in which villagers were arrested, tied up, and burned to death while still alive.

Spring Revolution – Mass Killings Civilians in 2025

Details of all 114 massacres committed by the military junta in 2025 in chronological order with the links from local media Facebook pages.

THE 1ST MASSACRE

Date & Time: January 16

Location: Nattalin, Sisone Kone Village, Nattalin Township, Bago Region

Casualties: 10 people killed

Summary: On January 15, approximately 100 soldiers from the 66th and 77th Brigades of the military junta and the Defense Equipment Factory reportedly raided Si Son Kone village in Nattalin Region. During this raid, the villagers fled, but 10 individuals who were unable to escape were captured and killed on the village road. Ko Chet Phong, Ko Min Htike, Ko Kyaw Kyaw, and Ko Than Zaw Oo were among the deceased. The troops are said to have looted and set fire to the houses in Si Son Kone, home to over 600 residents. The violence reportedly followed clashes between the military junta and local resistance groups in Si Son Kone in December 2024.

THE 2ND MASSACRE

Date & Time: January 31, around 5:30 p.m.

Location: Kalay Tsp. South Kokko Village, Kalay Township, Sagaing Region

Casualties: As of February 1, 9 deaths, including a child and a woman, have been confirmed

Summary: At approximately 5:30 p.m. on January 31, the military council conducted an airstrike on Kukkol Village in southern Kalay, Sagaing Region, dropping two 500-pound bombs onto houses sheltering war refugees. The attack claimed the lives of nine people—including four children—and left more than thirty injured. Among those killed were a five-year-old boy, three girls under 18, a pregnant woman, two mothers, and an elderly woman. According to the Kalay Township Police Department (KTP), the remains of three victims could not be recovered.

“A pair of fighter jets dropped bombs twice, then strafed the area with machine gun fire. At least nine casualties have been confirmed, but there may be more among the unidentifiable

fragments. Thirty others suffered serious injuries, including severed limbs,” a local resident reported.

THE 3RD MASSACRE

Date & Time: February 19, approximately 1:19 a.m.

Location: Hnin-Ee Village, Wet Ngin Village, Momauck Township, Kachin State

Casualties: 9 deaths, including a child and a woman, have been confirmed

Summary: At approximately 1:19 a.m. on February 19, a military jet dropped four bombs on the villages of Nan I Shan and Wet Yin in Momauk Region, Kachin State. The airstrike conducted by the Myanmar military junta resulted in the tragic death of seven family members, including three children. The victims from Wet Yin village were: 53-year-old U Maung Oo, 56-year-old Daw Aik Saw, 25-year-old U Seng Lian, 22-year-old Daw Cherry Htwe, 3-year-old Makaliya, 10-year-old Mayun Mi Misar, and 9-year-old Maung Aung Lin Htet. Additionally, nine other individuals sustained injuries, and four houses were destroyed in Nan Ee village. This occurred despite the absence of active fighting in the area.

THE 4TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: February 28 at midnight

Location: Kyaikangpyin Headquarters, Maungdaw Township, Rakhine State. Maungdaw Township

Casualties: more than 30 POW soldiers killed

Summary: On the night of February 28, two jet fighters from the Myanmar military junta dropped two 500-pound bombs on the former Kyikang Pyin border guard camp in northern Maungdaw Region, Rakhine State. The bombs detonated in the barracks where military equipment was stored, resulting in the deaths of over 30 prisoners of war and injuring more than 10 individuals.

THE 5TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 3, around 1:00 a.m.

Location: 9 villages in Pauk and Myaing Township, Magway Region

Casualties : 15 people died

Summary: On March 3, the Myaing PaKhaPha Civil Defense Force reported that 15 individuals were killed and 20 others injured after the military conducted airstrikes on villages in Pauk Township and Myaing Township.

“Between 1:30 and 2:30, three fighter jets targeted civilian areas. This was done intentionally, as there was no fighting and no military camps present. The casualties occurred due to these bombings,” stated an official from the Myaing PakaPha.

The airstrikes resulted in the deaths of four villagers from Baung Bin village, six from Letpanto village, three from Thayetkan village, one from Set Chey village, and one from Nyaung Kone village.

THE 6TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 4, 10:30 p.m.

Location: Nat Qont Village, Taungtha Township, Mandalay Region,
Taungtha Township

Casualties: 6 people killed, 30 houses destroyed in fire

Summary: On March 4, at approximately 10:30 p.m., the Myanmar military junta conducted airstrikes on Nattaw village in Taungtha Township, Mandalay Region. The attacks resulted in the deaths of six civilians and the destruction of approximately thirty houses by fire.

THE 7TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 5, in the morning

Location: Myesuntaw Village, Yesagyo Township, Magway Region

Casualties: 5 people died

Summary: On March 5, the Myanmar military junta, advancing on Yele Kyun in YeSaKyo Township, Magway Region, killed five individuals and set fire to nearly the entire village of Myi Suen Daw.

"We discovered five bodies. There were also elderly individuals who were unable to flee. Additionally, we found a mentally ill person who had been tied up and burned to death, and another victim who had been shot in a nearby forest," reported a local resident.

THE 8TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 14, 3:30 p.m.

Location: Letpanhla Village, Singu Township, Mandalay Region
Township

Casualties: 27 people died, including 6 children, aged 1 month

Summary : On March 14, the Myanmar military junta conducted an airstrike on Letpanhla village in Singu Township, Mandalay Region. The attack resulted in the deaths of 30 individuals, including six children, and injured at least 30 others.

THE 9TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 16, four bombs at 5:26 p.m. and 27 p.m., machine gun at 5:32 p.m. and 5:33 p.m.

Location: SeinYadanar Monastery, NaungCho Tsp, NaungCho Township, Northern Shan State

Casualties: 8 Buddhist Novices, One Buddhist Monk , 5 men and 5 women, totaling 14 dead

Summary: On March 16, the Myanmar military junta conducted four airstrikes on the Sein Yadana Monastery in Naung Cho Township, northern Shan State. The attacks resulted in the deaths of 14 individuals, including eight Buddhist novices, one Buddhist monk, two men, and three women.

THE 10TH MASSACRE

Date & Time: March 22, 8:38 a.m.
